Ms. Jewel Nana Thompson is a social impact strategist, public speaker, and business analyst with a focus on business development. She's an Assistant Lecturer of Entrepreneurship and researcher at Ashesi University. She teaches Foundations of Design and Entrepreneurship (FDE), Social Enterprise course and Organizational Behavior courses. She is the Incubator Manager and Operations Lead for the Ashesi Venture Incubator of the NEXT (New Entrepreneurs Xchange for Transformation) Idea to Impact Project a collaboration between Ashesi and Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) D-Lab.

She also led the innovation lab at the Design and Technology Institute in Accra, helping to facilitate the design of the curriculum and taught the inaugural cohort of students how to solve business challenges with the use of the design thinking methodology. Prior to joining Ashesi and DTI she was the Small Business Program Manager/Financial Wellbeing Coach for Operation HOPE. In her position she not only provided consultations for aspiring small business owners and existing small business owners within these communities but facilitated an entrepreneur training program that successfully incubated, educated, and graduated over 100 businesses. In addition to this role, she was the on-site credit and money management counselor with Operation HOPE's partnership with BB&T Bank (now Truist Bank). Her training sessions were pivotal in teaching participants how to scale their businesses and seek funding to which aided in helping entrepreneurs secure over 200K in funding.

She is the co-founder of a tech platform called LITH, Africa (leveraging intuitive technology for health) which integrates CBT (cognitive behavioral therapy) and machine learning to support the mental well-being of African college students, the platform is currently in beta testing. She is the founder of Eco-Launch, a Ghanaian based business advisory firm that supports early growth African social impact startups that seek to expand their offerings globally through business training, strategy development, and access to financial tools

Ms. Thompson has over ten years of combined experience researching, consulting, and helping to build businesses by teaching the theories of business management, orienting students/participants with the inclusion of the design thinking methodology to spark innovative business solutions and include the application of data analysis to understand the historical insights of business development. Additionally, Ms. Thompson developed and co-chaired the Young African Leaders Conference in 2010, from this she continued to create programming geared towards the empowerment of young African millennials in the city of Atlanta prior to moving to Ghana in 2018. She is the former Curator and former membership chair for the World Economic Forum Global Shapers Atlanta Hub. She was invited to speak on value driven private and public partnerships at the ACM convening at the World Economic Forum headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland.
